Signing Day Information Sheet

What is my payment schedule?	<p>The cost of the program is \$575 per year. This covers the fall and spring season. Players with multiple children will have sibling discounts. Additional children in the Excel program will receive a \$25 discount. Additional children in the rec program will receive a \$10 discount. Fees will be broken down into five payments, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><u>\$135.00</u> due at signing (uniforms are an additional cost and are paid directly to the uniform supplier)<u>\$110.00</u> due 7/1/11<u>\$110.00</u> due 8/1/11<u>\$110.00</u> due 9/1/11<u>\$110.00</u> due 10/1/11
Short season team fees	<p>There is a possibility that U15 and older teams will not play in the spring. If they do not play a full season they still have the opportunity to play a short season, which means they will play five games instead of ten. For this reason, they are on a different fee schedule. The cost of the short season program is \$290 in the fall and \$190 in the spring. If the team does not form in the spring, there will be no fees in the spring. Players with multiple children will still receive the same sibling discounts. Fees will be broken down into five payments, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><u>\$130.00</u> due at signing (uniforms are an additional cost and are paid directly to the uniform supplier)<u>\$80.00</u> due 7/1/11<u>\$80.00</u> due 8/1/11
Fundraisers	<p>Fundraisers will be available several times throughout the year. Monies raised by your player will be credited to their account and can be used for registration fee payment, tournaments or camps. If your account has been paid in full, credit will still be given and can roll over to the next year's fees. The Coke Fundraiser will begin on signing day and will be due on opening day, Saturday, September 10th. We will have an additional fundraiser, the Tidal Wave Fundraiser, which you will receive more information on after the Coke Fundraiser. This money was used to pay for camps and registrations. We will also have a club fundraiser. This will be the discount cards. This year, Gerry has added the concessions stand to the card.</p>
Coke Fundraiser	<p>The Coke Fundraiser will begin on signing day and will be due on opening day, Saturday, September 10th. You can turn your fundraiser in anytime before September 10th. If you turn your order in early, you will receive your products one week later. You may still continue to sell coke products and turn in multiple times throughout the season. Profits are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">20oz carbonated drinks 3.00 (if the club sells under 150)20oz carbonated drinks 5.00 (if the club sells over 150)12oz carbonated drinks 5.50 (no minimum)20oz DASANI (24 pack) 7.0012oz DASANI (24 pack) 4.5020oz Powerade (24 pack) 3.0010oz Minute Maid (24 pack) 7.50Tum-E-Yummies (12 pack) 5.00

<p>How can I pay?</p>	<p>There are several ways to make your payment at GYSA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ By credit card on the Griffin Soccer website. <p>Will there be additional fees during the season?</p>	<p>In addition to the scheduled season games, each team will play an additional one to three tournaments each season. This will incur an additional cost for each player. More information on tournaments will be given to you by your players coach. Before you schedule vacations, please check with your coaches as to which tournaments they plan on attending. Commitment to the season also means a commitment to the tournaments.</p>
<p>Where will we be playing and how many games will we be playing?</p>	<p>Venues for the Academy games will cover areas such as Peachtree City, Macon, Henry County and Coweta. The Academy program can, and probably will, play more than ten games per season. Many times more than one game will be played per day. Venues for the Select program will cover areas as far away as Kennesaw and Gainesville. There will be five home games and five away games. In the Select program, there will not be more than one game played per day unless you are playing in a tournament.</p>
<p>Uniforms and practice shirt</p>	<p>Each player will choose three different jersey numbers and will be assigned one of those numbers prior to the season. You will be notified if there is a problem with your number. Uniforms will be shipped to your home prior to the first game of the fall season. If you have not received your uniform by August 15, call Gerry Cunningham at 770-229-8936. Uniform orders must be in by June 24th. Included in your uniform order is a practice t-shirt, which you will receive by Select Camp. Make sure you wear your practice shirt to practices. If you start practicing before Select Camp, wear a plain white t-shirt.</p>
<p>When will schedules be available?</p>	<p>Schedules for each season will be available NO EARLIER than one week prior to the season opener game. Fall season will open on Saturday, September 10th. Schedules will be posted on the website, www.griffinsoccer.org. There is a schedules tab on the left side of the home page.</p>
<p>Merchandise Store</p>	<p>Soccer merchandise and equipment is available for purchase behind the snack bar. Items available for purchase are shin-guards, goalie gloves, jerseys, balls, and other miscellaneous items. Items are available for purchase whenever the concession stand is open.</p>
